

Town of Erin Broadband Internet Survey 2020

This message is for Town of Erin residents: 3 years ago, many of us filled out a County survey about whether or not we had broadband internet access. I would like to think the overwhelming response from our town, especially compared to other towns nearby, is part of the reason we have miles of new Spectrum cable built out in the last two years.

Also based on that data, the Town Supervisor and myself have been conversing with a representative of a broadband company that is interested in investing in our town. The problem is that we no longer can keep up with where Spectrum has built out and where it hasn't so, we need your help. We need to know as many addresses as possible of people that **DO NOT** have Spectrum access or Spectrum cable running in front of their homes. This is Town of Erin only regardless of mailing address.

We need this information quickly....We have about a week and a half to respond with some sort of map to this company. Without this information we might lose a great opportunity to get true broadband access to more people in our town which is especially critical during the COVID-19 pandemic.

Please email our town clerk at etownclerk@stny.rr.com and put **Broadband survey** in the subject line. In the body of your email I only need:

- 1) Your address and simply state that you do not have any high-speed internet service available.
- 2) ******Perhaps most importantly please include in your email if you have any K 12 students WITHOUT true broadband. Home schooling counts for this as well.******

Satellite dishes and "jet packs" are not broadband so if you have these please let us know that you do not have broadband available.

Please share this as much as you can. Please reach out to your neighbors and if you want to submit a group email (with individual addresses in the body of the email) that would be fine. You can drop off a 3 x 5 card at Town Hall. I don't care how we get this data we need as much as we can get as fast as possible.
